The menu focuses on fresh, made-to-order sandwiches, homemade soups, crisp salads, and bakery favorites.

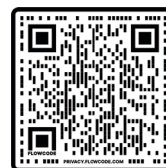
Early customer favorites include the chocolate croissants, hearty Italian Beef sandwich, and a fresh salad bar.
