One of Black Cat Café's greatest strengths is its diverse menu. Rather than focusing on a single style of cooking, Prado has created a menu with something for nearly every

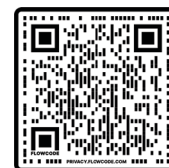
